witnesses to that.

Responsorial Psalm:

Preserve me, Lord, I take refuge in you.

(Optional Sequence)

Gospel Acclamation:

Alleluia, Alleluia! This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad. Alleluia!

Gospel: Matthew 28: 8-15

Tell my brothers that they must leave for Galilee; they will see me there.

Communion Antiphon:

Christ, having risen from the dead, dies now no more; death will no longer have dominion over him, alleluia.

TUESDAY EASTER OCTAVE

Entrance Antiphon:

He gave them the water of wisdom to drink; it will be made strong in them and will not be moved; it will raise them up for ever, alleluia.

The Gloria

First Reading: Acts 2: 36-41

You must repent and everyone of you must be baptised in the name of Jesus.

Responsorial Psalm:

The Lord fills the earth with his love.

(Optional Sequence)

Gospel Acclamation:

Alleluia, Alleluia! This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad. Alleluia!

Gospel: John 20: 11-18

I have seen the Lord and he has spoken to me.

Communion Antiphon:

If you have risen with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God; mind the things that are above, alleluia.

WEDNESDAY EASTER OCTAVE

Entrance Antiphon:

Come, you blessed of my Father; receive the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world, alleluia.

The Gloria

First Reading: Acts 3: 1-10

I will give you what I have: in the name of Jesus stand up and walk!

Responsorial Psalm:

Let the hearts that seek the Lord rejoice.

(Optional Sequence)

Gospel Acclamation:

Alleluia, Alleluia! This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad. Alleluia!

Gospel: Luke 24: 13-35

They recognised Jesus at the breaking of bread.

Communion Antiphon:

The disciples recognised the Lord Jesus in the breaking of the bread, alleluia.

THURSDAY EASTER OCTAVE

Entrance Antiphon:

They praised in unison your conquering hand, O Lord, for wisdom opened mouths that were mute and gave eloquence to the tongues of infants, alleluia.

The Gloria

First Reading: Acts 3: 11-26

You killed the prince of life. God, however, raised him from the dead.

Responsorial Psalm:

How great is your name, O Lord our God, through all the earth!

(Optional Sequence)

Gospel Acclamation:

Alleluia, Alleluia! This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad. Alleluia!

Gospel: Luke 24: 35-48

It is written that the Christ would suffer and on the third day he would rise from the dead.

Communion Antiphon:

O chosen people, proclaim the mighty works of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light, alleluia.

FRIDAY EASTER OCTAVE

Entrance Antiphon:

The Lord led his people in hope, while the sea engulfed their foes, alleluia.

The Gloria

First Reading: Acts 4: 1-12

This is the only name by which we can be saved.

Responsorial Psalm:

The stone which the builders rejected has become the corner stone.
