Welcome Back

Especially to those who are here for the first time this weekend since March. It is good to see you.

Please take this newsletter (and any other leaflets that you have handled) with you at the end of Mass, because they cannot be used again by other people and it is safer if you dispose of them at home.

Volunteers Needed

One of the requirements for us opening the church for Mass is that we always have stewards (at least two) on duty at every Mass. Arrangements have been made for this weekend and next, but to sustain this system over the coming months we will need a good team of volunteers to set up a rota that is sustainable and not too burdensome for any single volunteer. The stewards not only welcome visitors and inform them of the requirements, but they also oversee the cleaning of the church after every Mass, again another requirement, to ensure that the building is properly sanitised for the next congregation.

Richard Cassidy has very kindly agreed to act as the coordinator of the team of volunteers and to draw up a rota. We will need volunteers for weekend and weekday Masses. You can speak to him today or you can contact him at richard_cassidy@sky.com or on 07930 610717. Richard can give you the details of what is required of those who are stewards. Fr Aidan can also let you have these details as well.

For the time being we will not have more than one Mass / service per day in church. This means that there will be no 8.30 Mass on Sunday or 12 noon Mass on

Saturday. We need to have a team of stewards that can sustain the rota over what could be a fairly lengthy period, so the full schedule of Masses will be phased in.
