NOVEMBER INDULGENCES FOR THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED

A plenary indulgence, applicable to the souls in purgatory, is granted to those who

a) on any day in November, visit a cemetery and pray for the departed;

b) on any day in November, visit a church or an oratory and recite the Our Father and the Creed.



A <u>partial</u> indulgence, applicable to the souls in purgatory, is granted to the faithful who devoutly recite the prayer **Eternal Rest** ... on any date.

As with all indulgences, these are granted on fulfilment of the necessary conditions, i.e. Confession, Communion and prayers for the Holy Father's intentions.


