If you would like your deceased relatives and friends to be remembered at Mass throughout November, please take an envelope from the church porch and

return it with the names of those whom you wish to be included listed inside. It is customary to place an offering in the envelope as well. Most weekday

Masses in November will be offered for the repose of the souls of those named on the Pious List.

From the beginning, the Church has honoured the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic

Sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God.

NOVEMBER INDULGENCES FOR THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED

A plenary indulgence, applicable to the souls in purgatory, is granted to those who

- a) on any day in November, visit a cemetery and pray for the departed;
- b) on any day in November, visit a church or an oratory and recite the Our Father and the Creed.

A partial indulgence, applicable to the souls in purgatory, is granted to the faithful who devoutly recite the prayer **Eternal Rest ...** on any date.



As with all indulgences, these are granted on fulfilment of the necessary conditions, i.e. Confession, Communion and prayers for the Holy Father's intentions.

The Holy Father's intention for November 2022 is "We pray for children who are suffering, especially those who are homeless, orphans and victims of war.
