

St. Austin's School Admissions September 2023

Any child born between 1st September 2018 and 31st August 2019 will be due to start reception class September 2023. The deadline for submitting your application forms to both the Local Authority and our school is 15th January 2023. We will be holding the last meeting for parents/carers to have a look around the school and collect all the relevant forms. There will be a maximum of 2 adults per child allowed to attend, and strictly no children are allowed on this occasion.
