## CHRISTMAS CRIB

When we bless our crib at the Christmas Masses this year, we will be doing so on the 800<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first crib blessing. It was St Francis of Assisi, the patron of our church, who made the first Christmas creche or manger for Christmas Eve of 1223. However, as early as the fourth century, representations of the nativity of Our Lord were painted as wall decorations, depicting the Gospel accounts of Christ's birth and also the belief that He was born in the midst of animals in a manger.
