A *plenary* indulgence, applicable to the souls in purgatory, is granted to those who :

- a) on any day in November, visit a cemetery and pray for the departed;
- b) on any day in November, visit a church or an oratory and recite the Our Father and the Creed.

A *partial* indulgence, applicable to the souls in purgatory, is granted to the faithful who devoutly recite the prayer **Eternal Rest ...** on any date.

As with all indulgences, these are granted on fulfilment of the usual conditions, i.e. Confession, Communion and prayers for the Holy Father's intentions.
