BLESSING OF CRIB FIGURES

The blessing of Baby Jesus crib figures (and other crib figures) will take place at the end of all three Masses this weekend. This custom, which is now observed widely throughout the Church, was first introduced by Pope St Paul VI at the Vatican in 1969.

1923 LOURDES CURE DECLARED MIRACULOUS

Mr John ("Jack") Traynor, a Liverpool resident who took part in the archdiocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes in 1923, was cured of epilepsy, paralysis of the right arm and paraplegia while at the shrine. Three years later, a group of doctors concluded that "the process of this prodigious healing is absolutely outside and above the forces of nature". Now, 101 years after this healing took place, it has been officially recognized as miraculous. Here is an extract from Archbishop McMahon's statement on the case, which is dated 8 December 2024:

Given the weight of medical evidence, the testimony to the faith of John Traynor and his devotion to Our Blessed Lady, it is with great joy that I declare that the cure of John Traynor, from multiple serious medical conditions, is to be recognized as a miracle wrought by the power of God through the intercession of Our Lady of Lourdes. I hope that in February 2025, during the Jubilee Year, we will have a fitting celebration at the Metropolitan Cathedral to mark this significant moment in the history of our archdiocese, helping us all to respond to the Jubilee call to be "Pilgrims of Hope".
