ENROLMENT INTO THE GUILD OF ST STEPHEN

Two of our altar servers will be enrolled into the Archconfraternity (or "Guild") of St Stephen this weekend: Miss **Joelene Ansah** at the 9.30 Mass, and Miss **Olanna Eze** at 11.30. The Guild exists "to sanctify servers by helping them to understand the holiness of the office; [and] to help them understand more fully the sacraments in which they play such an active role, especially the Eucharist". The Guild Prayer, which members are asked to say every day, expresses the importance of their ministry:

CLOSURE OF CENACLE CONVENT

For those who may not know, the Convent of Our Lady of the Cenacle in Wavertree will sadly be closing soon. The Sisters' popular Prayer Enrolment Ministry will also send in its current form. Many will be sorry to see the end of this ministry, which has brought spiritual benefits to countless people. The House and the Prayer Enrolment Office will close finally on 31 October, with inperson enrolments ending on 24 October, and the last postal and online orders being taken a week earlier on 17 October.

This closure is accompanied by the following assurance from the Sisters:

For those who have arranged annual and perpetual Mass offerings, we can guarantee that the sharing of Masses and prayers by the Cenacle Sisters will continue to be honoured. We remain present in England, Europe and more internationally, and our commitment to praying for people who have been enrolled in this ministry will not cease.
