### **NOVEMBER PIOUS LIST**

If you would like your deceased relatives and friends to be remembered at Mass in November, please take an envelope from the church porch and return it with the names of those whom you wish to be included listed inside. It is customary to place an offering in the envelope as well. Many weekday Masses in November will be offered for the repose of the souls of those on the Pious List.

### **NOVEMBER INDULGENCE FOR THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED**

A *plenary* indulgence, applicable to the souls in purgatory, is granted to those who :

- a) on any day in November, visit a cemetery and pray for the departed;
- b) on any day in November, visit a church or an oratory and recite the Our Father and the Creed.

A *partial* indulgence, applicable to the souls in purgatory, is granted to the faithful who devoutly recite the prayer **Eternal Rest ...** on any date.

As with all indulgences, these are granted on fulfilment of the usual conditions, i.e. Confession, Holy Communion and prayers for the Pope's intentions.

### **DEANERY MASS**

The deanery to which our parish belongs, Liverpool South, has the martyr St John Almond (1577-1612) as its patron saint. His feast day is 5 December, and at 7.00 pm on that date this year, a Deanery Mass will be celebrated at St Charles', Aigburth, L17 9PG.
