On the nine days between Good Friday and the second Sunday of Easter, it is possible to pray a Novena in preparation for the Feast of Divine Mercy, which falls on the second Sunday of Easter. These are the intentions for each day of the Novena :

- 1. All mankind, especially all sinners.**
- 2. The souls of priests and religious.**
- 3. All devout and faithful souls.**
- 4. Pagans and those who do not yet know Christ.**
- 5. The souls of those who have separated themselves from the Church.**
- 6. Meek and humble souls, and the souls of little children.**
- 7. Souls who especially venerate and glorify the Divine Mercy.**
- 8. Souls who are in the prison of purgatory.**
- 9. Souls who have become lukewarm.**

YOUNG ADULTS' PILGRIMAGE TO ASSISI

The Archdiocese is arranging a pilgrimage to Assisi for people aged **18 to 35**, to take place from **29 November – 2 December 2026**. Walking in the footsteps of St Francis during his 800th anniversary year, some of the key sites involving St Francis and St Clare will be visited, as well as those linked with St Carlo Acutis. The full tour price is **£990**, which includes all meals (apart from one dinner), shared accommodation, flights, all transport and the itinerary. For bookings received by 10 April, there is an advance booking price of **£940** per person sharing a twin room.
